ECFiber Expands Its Real Broadband Service Again

Royalton VT – May 1, 2015

The East Central Vermont Community Fiber-Optic Network (“ECFiber”) is continuing its steady growth, opening an eight mile extension in the towns of Chelsea and Tunbridge passing about 80 potential subscribers on parts of East Randolph Road, Brook Road, Nicholette Road, Hook Road, Burbank Crossroad, Chelsea Line Road, Dickerman Hill Road, and Whitney Hill Road.

“This is the first of several expansions we’ll be opening this summer,” said Irv Thomae, Chairman of ECFiber and Governing Board delegate from Norwich. “We’re pleased that more residents in this area are now able to enjoy the benefits of locally grown, full time, state-of-the-art real broadband,”

ECFiber is a consortium of 24 towns in East-Central Vermont. Step by step, we are building a community-owned fiber-optic network to deliver high-speed Internet to every home, business, or civic institution in our territory. ECFiber offers real broadband: symmetrical internet access (same upload as download,) speeds of up to 400 Mbps that do not vary by time of day or according to the weather - as well as phone service with unlimited USA and Canada long distance calling.
